As a member of Ely Tri Club you are expected to abide by the following club rules that apply to young persons between the ages of 15-17.

- All members must remember they are representing the club and act appropriately at all times.
- Suitable clothing for each discipline must be worn at all times; Club kit should be worn when competing in events when entered as an Ely Tri Club athlete.
- Members must keep to agreed timings for training and events; if they are going to attend late or not at all they must inform the coach or session leader.
- All members must compete within the rules of the club and respect the Coaches/officials and respect their decisions.
- All members must respect fellow competitors; coaches and officials.
- Members must not, at any time, take any kind of banned or illegal performance enhancing substances.
- Members must not smoke or consume alcohol whilst attending training sessions OR competing at events representing or organised by Ely Tri Club.
- Members will comply with coaches decisions where sessions are risk assessed as not suitable for young persons aged between 15-17. Failure will result in membership being withdrawn.
